that any senior in Bossier parish that wants or needs a meal gets one, ensuring that transportation to medical care & grocery stores is available throughout the parish & keeping in-home supports a priority. All of our clients &/or their caregiver must have a current assessment on file in order to receive services. Our goal is to complete any new assessments or reassessments via our 'mobile' portal in an effort to reduce start time for services. As a reminder, all of our services are available at little to no cost to our clients. We do accept contributions for services received & all contributions stay within in the program received.

Many seniors may have made changes to their Medicare program during open enrollment. It is good to remember that if you have any concerns about your new plan, you may be eligible to change back to your original plan until March 31st.
