e have been so excited to finally welcome clients back to our sites! We have been able to have activities at our Bearkat, Haughton & Plain Dealing site. Due to roof repairs at the Benton site, we will not be starting activities there until August. It has been both challenging and rewarding in welcoming our seniors back. We still have to comply with guidelines from the Governor's Office of Elderly Affairs, as well as Louisiana Department of Health. We do not require proof of ANY vaccination status to receive services. However, clients are strongly encouraged to practice

social distancing, proper hand sanitizing and to wear a face mask when they feel it is appropriate. We also are enforcing capacity limitations at each site along with offering a limited amount of activities that we can support with our staff.

Our focus is to continue to offer meals to any senior over sixty in Bossier parish that needs one. We have multiple ways that we are serving meals throughout the parish at this time. Our traditional "Meals on Wheels" delivered Monday – Thursday by our staff & volunteers. Mom's Meals delivers 10 meals every two weeks & grab 'n go at our Bearkat site for clients that live in Bossier City & drive.

We also recognize that transportation to medical appointments & the grocery store remains a high priority for our seniors. We offer medical transportation Monday – Friday for \$10 round trip or no cost if ride is booked through Medicaid. Transportation to the grocery store is also available. You may call for more information & schedule. Clients riding our buses MUST wear a face mask per FTA guidelines.

Our hope and goal is that with all our efforts, our sites can remain open and offer some support through exercise programs and grab 'n go meals. We remain diligent in our dedication to the safety of our staff & seniors.

• **CAREGIVER CLIENTS:** raised toilet seat, wheelchair cushion, incontinence supplies- diapers, pads, pull-ups (sizes vary), Walkers; (subject to availability)

• **NOTE:** The Bossier Fire Department is offering FREE smoke alarms for our seniors that don't have them. They come and install them for you, and remember: **"THEY MAY SAVE YOUR LIFE"!**

LEMONADE PIE

- 1 5 oz. can Pet milk; (evaporated milk)
- 1 box, Instant Lemon Pudding Mix
- 2 8 oz. Cream Cheese

³/₄ cup frozen lemonade concentrate

In a small bowl combine Pet milk and ³/₄ pudding mix, beating on low speed for 2 minutes - **Mixture will be thick**

In medium bowl beat cream cheese until light and fluffy (about 3 minutes), gradually add in the remaining pudding mixture; Pour into graham cracker crust. YUM!
